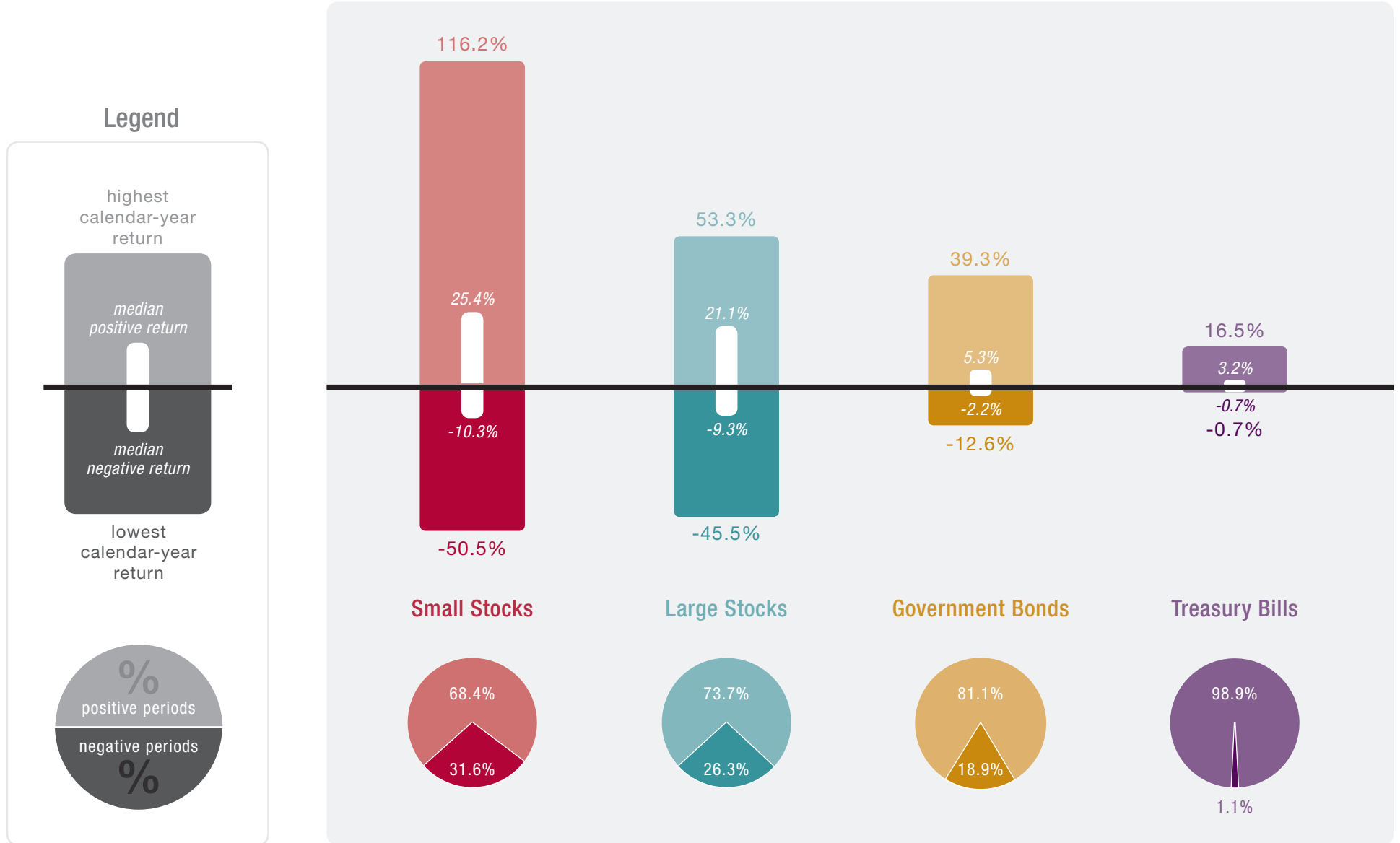


Long-Term Asset-Class Performance 1926 - 2020
