

CRSPMI HISTORICAL DATABASE RELEASE NOTES

JUNE 2025 QUARTERLY UPDATE

These release notes pertain to the June 2025 quarterly release of the CRSPMI Historical Database, formerly called the CRSPMI 2013 Historical Indexes database, available in July 2025. The updated [CRSPMI Historical Database Guide](#) is available on our website. With the June 2025 release, two additional years of data—2011 and 2012—are now available. There is no change to how these files may be retrieved.

PRODUCT BACKGROUND INFORMATION

In October 2023 CRSP released a new research data product available with the 202309 quarterly data cut. Data is available quarterly, with a one month lag.

The CRSPMI Historical Database provides day-by-day index levels, opening and closing constituents, and pro forma data from CRSP's suite of investable Market Indexes from 2011 to present day.

INDEX FILE FORMAT CHANGES

CRSP increased the decimal precision for two constituent multiplier fields, Concentration Multiplier and Received Stock Multiplier, from 6 decimals (10,6) to 20 decimals (28,20), beginning in files dated October 24, 2024. The field names affected are Conc_Mplier and RS_Mplier in FTP Constituent Open/Close/PF and Projection files.

CRSP also updated the field "Permno" in Constituent files to "PERMNO". PERMNO® is the proprietary reference key for all securities data maintained by CRSP. Developed in the 1960s, PERMNOs are permanent, unambiguous identifiers for all US-listed equities that are consistent through time over the life of each security, accounting for mergers, spinoffs, distributions and all types of corporate events.

DELIVERY METHOD

CRSP data delivery for all products is available through the Cloud, utilizing IPSwitch's MOVEit Cloud product, as well as through Wharton Research Data Services, WRDS.

ZIP INSTALLS

CRSP uses a zip process for data installation. ZIP utilities that are standard on all platforms should work to unzip the databases. On Windows computers, CRSP recommends using 7-ZIP, which can be downloaded from this site:

Several important items to note follow:

- All directories are extracted to lower case letters. For example: C:\crspdata\mh201308
- All Windows Users: Extracting a zipped file does not create an installed program in Windows. It will not show in the Windows Control Panel. When uninstalling the data, just delete the directories that contain the detailed files.

DATA FORMAT: FLAT FILE ASCII

Product Name: ASCII Zip

File Name: MHZ202309_ASCII.ZIP

STEPS TO INSTALL:

- From the directory containing your downloaded zip file, right click (in Windows)
- Set the extract destination to the current higher level directory where data is normally stored and unzip will add the rest of the path (default is C:\ in Windows)
- For example, in Windows, extracting to C:\ will install the data under C:\crspdata
